# Ola Electric enters **BESS** market with 'Ola Shakti' launch

**FE BUREAU** Bengaluru, October 16

BHAVISH AGGARWAL-LED Ola Electric on Thursday announced the launch of Ola Shakti, a portable device that can be used to power ACs and refrigerators at home, water pumps at farms and business establishments, marking its entry into the battery energy storage systems (BESS) market.

Ola Shakti is powered by Ola's own 4680 Bharat Cells that are manufactured at its Gigafactory in Krishnagiri, Tamil Nadu. The company expects its annual Gigafactory consumption for the BESS market to scale up to 5 GWh in the next couple of years, potentially exceeding its automotive consumption.

The system leverages Ola Electric's existing cell technology, Gigafactory infrastructure, and pan-India distribution network, enabling rapid scaling without additional capital expenditure or research and development (R&D) investment, the company said.

"India doesn't face energy shortage; it faces an energy storage opportunity. With Ola Shakti, we are turning that opportunity into energy independence," said Bhavish Aggarwal, chairman and MD, Ola Electric.

# Titagarh Rail plans 20x rise in coach production

MANU KAUSHIK New Delhi, October 16

IN LINE WITH the Indian Railways'strong push towards the passenger segment, Titagarh Rail Systems (TRSL) is planning to ramp up its production of passenger coaches by 20fold from just 12 coaches in FY25 to an expected 240 coaches in FY27. Prithish Chowdhary, deputy MD of TRSL, told *FE* that the growth in passenger segment is supported by orders for Vande Bharat sleeper trains, and metro projects in Ahmedabad, Surat, Bengaluru and Mumbai.

"The growth story really starts from this year in the passenger business. The primary growth driver for Titagrah over the next few years would be the passenger rail systems business. Today, we have an installed capacity of around 300 coaches per annum, and by 2028, this will be up to 850 coaches per annum. We are envisaging a huge ramp up in the coach production capacity," Chowdhary said.

In 2023, the company achieved a key milestone by winning the ₹24,000-crore contract, in a partnership with BHEL, for the manufacturing and maintenance of 80 semi high-speed sleeper Vande Bharattrains.Prior to that,TRSL, which was primarily focused on the freight wagon manufacturing, bagged its first metro contract for Pune in 2019 to intro-India's duce first-ever aluminium-bodied coaches.

Analysts said TRSL's strategic

shift towards growth is evident as of mid-2025 with passenger rail systems (PRS) division constituting approximately 62% of the company's ₹24,500 crore consolidated order book, a significant departure from its historical freight dominance.

"The company is rapidly scaling up its Uttarpara facility, including a leased 40-acre expansion, with plans to increase coach production potentially up to 1,200 units. This expansion will service major contracts for: metro coaches, and Vande Bharat Sleeper trains. Supported by strong policy backing and massive infrastructure investment, the PRS segment is projected to grow at a CAGR of 38-39% through 2029," said a recent report from Asit C Mehta Investment Intermediates (ACMIIL).

# Bharat Forge, Rolls-Royce sign pact

facility in Dahlewitz, near Berlin. Sashi Mukundan, executive vice president of Transformation at Rolls-Royce India, said

this contract will help develop world-class manufacturing capabilities in India, enabling the delivery of aerospace components to the global supply chain ecosystem.

Amit Kalyani, vice chairman and joint managing director of Bharat Forge, said the Pearl engine family represents

the future of high-performance aviation.

The Pearl 10X powers some of the largest, fastest, and longest-range business jets. Bharat Forge is the first and only company in India to offer this advanced technology for precision aerospace components used in the Pearl engine family.

Rolls-Royce began collaborating with Bharat Forge in 2020, sourcing parts for the Pearl 700 programme.

## Amazon sees 2.76 billion site visits this festive season

**FE BUREAU** New Delhi, October 16

AMAZON INDIA ON Thursday said the ongoing Great Indian Festival 2025 has attracted a record 2.76 billion customer visits, the highest ever for the annual event, with more than 70% of the traffic coming from tier 2 and 3 cities. With five days remaining in

the 30-day sale, the e-commerce major reported "unprecedented" engagement across key metrics, including customer savings and seller participation. The company said the event has already enabled over ₹1,000 crore in customer savings through bank offers, seller GST benefits, and cashback rewards.

"Our sellers and brand partners have seen multi-fold growth across categories such as smartphones, appliances and consumer electronics to home & kitchen, beauty, fashion, and more," said Saurabh Srivastava, vice-president, Amazon India.

The platform also recorded its highest-ever number of sellers registering sales, spanning smaller markets such as Kangra, Haridwar, Muzaffarpur, Jamnagar, Darjeeling, Shimoga, and Salem. Over two-thirds of participating small and medium businesses (SMBs) came from tier 2 and 3 cities.

Amazon Bazaar, the company's store for ultra-affordable products, saw over two times growth in seller participation this year. More than half of Bazaar sellers reported their best-ever single-day sales, while the number of sellers crossing ₹1 lakh in sales surged 15 times year-on-year. Eighteen states and Union Territories, including Madhya Pradesh, Assam, Punjab, and Andhra Pradesh, recorded their highest-ever seller sales milestones.

For Prime members, deliveries accelerated sharply, with over 40 million products delivered the same or next day, up 60% and 22% year-on-year, respectively. Amazon said its delivery network expanded significantly, with same- and nextday deliveries in metros up 29%, while two-day deliveries in tier 2 and 3 cities grew 37%. Nearly 70% of new Prime sign-

ups came from smaller towns. Amazon Business also saw robust traction during the sale, with new business customer sign-ups rising 30% y-o-y and bulk orders up nearly 120%.
